### LOCAL LAW No. 3 for the Year 2008

A Local Law in Relation to the Maximum Exemption Allowable for the Alternative Veterans Exemption pursuant to Section 458-a or the Real Property Law for Real Property Taxation in the Town of Howard

Section 1. The purpose of this law is to set the maximum veterans exemption allowable pursuant to section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of subdivision 2(d) of section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the maximum veterans exemption from real property taxes allowable pursuant to section 458-a of the Real Property

Tax Law is established as follows:

- (a) Qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of fifteen percent of the assessed value of such property; provided, however that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of Nine thousand dollars or the product of Nine thousand dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate of the Town of Howard.
- (b) In addition to the exemption provided by paragraph (a) of this sub division, where the veteran served in a combat theatre or combat zone of operations, as documented by the award of a United States campaign ribbon or service medal, qualifying residential real property also shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of ten percent of the assessed value of such property; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of Six thousand dollars or the product of Six thousand dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the Town of Howard.
- (c) In addition to the exemptions provided by paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subdivision, where the veteran received a compensation rating from the United States Veteran's Administration because of a service connected disability, qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of the product of the assessed value of such property multiplied by fifty percent of the veteran's disability rating; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of Thirty thousand dollars or the product of Thirty thousand dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the Town of Howard.

Section 3. Local Law No. 1 for the Year 1985 for the Town of Howard is hereby repealed and revoked, being replaced by this local law.

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Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
