# TOWN OF HOWARD VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS' PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION

### 1. TITLE

This law shall be known as the "Town of Howard Volunteer Firefighters' Property Tax Exemption".

#### 2. AUTHORITY

This law is enacted pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 466-a and Municipal Home Rule Law Section 10.

#### 3. PURPOSE

The Town Board recognizes the role of the volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers in securing the safety and well being of our communities. The Town Board hereby finds that it is in the best social and economic interests of the Town of Howard to encourage volunteerism for said purposes. To that end, by providing the following exemption it is the intent to so encourage volunteerism for our various fire and ambulance companies.

## 4. EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND AMBULANCE WORKERS.

- (a) Real property owned by an enrolled member of an incorporated volunteer fire company, fire department or incorporated voluntary ambulance service or such enrolled member and spouse residing in the Town of Howard shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of ten percent of the assessed value of such property for Town purposes, exclusive of special assessments provided, however, that such exemption shall in no event exceed \$3,000 multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the assessing unit in which such real property is located.
- (b) Such exemption shall not be granted to an enrolled member of an incorporated volunteer fire company, fire department or incorporated voluntary ambulance service residing in the Town unless:
  - (i) the applicant resides in the Town which is served by such incorporated volunteer fire company or fire department or incorporated voluntary ambulance service;
  - (ii) the property is the primary residence of the applicant;
  - (iii) the property is used exclusively for residential purposes; provided however, that in the event any portion of such property is not used exclusively for the applicant's residence but is used for other purposes, such portion shall be subject to taxation and the remaining portion only shall be entitled to the exemption provided by this section; and
  - (iv) the applicant has been certified by the authority having jurisdiction for the incorporated volunteer fire company or fire department as an enrolled member of such incorporated volunteer fire company or fire department for at least five years or the applicant has been certified by the authority having jurisdiction for the incorporated voluntary ambulance service as an enrolled member of such

incorporated voluntary ambulance service for at least five years. Said certification shall be made to the Chairman of the Town Board of Assessors.

- (c) Application for such exemption shall be filed with the assessor on or before the taxable status date on a form as prescribed by the state board.
- (d) No applicant who is a volunteer firefighter or volunteer ambulance worker who by reason of such status is receiving any benefit under the provisions of this article on the effective date of this section shall suffer any diminution of such benefit because of the provisions of this section.

### 5. CERTIFICATION

The person eligible to receive such exemption must submit annually to the Town Assessor's office, with his or her application for said exemption, a sworn statement, signed by two officers of said incorporated volunteer fire company, fire department or incorporated volunteer ambulance service, that certifies the years of service said person has given to the incorporated volunteer fire company, fire department or incorporated volunteer ambulance service and his or her continued active enrollment in said organization. The failure to submit this application and sworn statement to the Town Assessor's office by the applicable taxable status date shall disqualify said person for such exemption for the year associated therewith.

### 6. INCONSISTENCY

All other local laws and ordinances of the Town of Howard inconsistent with the provisions of this Local law are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this Local Law shall be in addition to such other local laws or ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this local law.

### 7. UNCONSTITUTIONALITY AND ILLEGALITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgement shall not affect, impair, or invalidate any paragraph, word, section or part thereof not directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement shall have been rendered.

### 8. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
