Town of Howard Logging Law (2023)

Purpose:

The purpose of this local law is to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Howard by ensuring that roads and highways within the Town of Howard are protected from damage and maintained in a safe condition.

Commercial logging operations are defined as the cutting, removal and sale of tree trunks that have been cut and stripped of all branches.

Required Notification:

Any person who, after the effective date of this local law, shall commence a commercial logging operation in the Town shall provide notification of such operation as prescribed below to the Town Clerk or the Highway Superintendent at least (10) ten business days before operations are to commence:

- 1. The name, address and telephone number of the property owner of record;
- 2. The tax map designation of the premises to be logged;
- 3. The name, telephone number, any temporary and the permanent address of the person or entity conducting the commercial logging operation;
- 4. The name, of the road to be utilized in removing logs including anticipated access points;
- 5. The anticipated period of time the logging operation will last from start to finish.
- 6. Logger shall indemnify the Town of any liability or damage resulting from its logging activities.

The Town Clerk upon receipt of such notification shall immediately forward the above information to the Highway Superintendent.

Highway Superintendent:

The Town Highway Superintendent shall have the authority to request reasonable actions to mitigate damage and ensure reasonable public safety on and within the public right of way.

The Town Highway Superintendent is furthermore empowered to impose reasonable restrictions as hereinafter set forth when a commercial logging operation may result in the creation of a hazardous condition to residents or damage to Town roads, regardless of weather condition. The Highway Superintendent may require the following of the logging operator:

- 1. The erection of signs indicating "truck entrance";
- 2. The installation of temporary culverts and/or planking at the entrance to a logging operation, which abuts a Town road;
- 3. Off-street parking for all vehicles relating to the commercial logging operation.

Exemption:

Town of Howard property owners who engage in logging activities as heretofore defined solely for their personal use, and not for resale to third parties, as logs, are hereby exempt from the provisions of this local law.

Damage:

If damage occurs on or within the right of way, because of commercial logging:

- 1. The Town will give the Logger an assessment of the expenses of repairs needed to restore the damage done. The Town may repair the road before logging ends, if necessary to keep the condition of the road safe. The Town will give the Logger notice of the need for repairs along with an assessment to make said repairs.
- 2. The Logger will have the right to object to the repair assessment. If the Logger objects, an independent assessor will be chosen and agreed upon by the Logger and the Town. The agreed upon assessor will control. The expense of the independent assessor will be borne by the Logger.

The provisions herein which refer to road, property, owner, logger, etc. shall be interpreted to cover one or multiple.

Penalty for failure to Notify:

On the first offense, logger will be given a written notice of first offense which shall be a warning.

On a second offense and any offense thereafter, logger will be given a fine of no less than \$350.00 but no more than \$500.00.
